

Using an MOD Rail Travel Warrant

If you attend an Army Cadet Course such as the Cadet Cookery Course or an Adventure Training Course, it can be very expensive and inconvenient to make your own travel arrangements to the destination. The Army Cadets will help with these costs by supplying you with a rail warrant. A rail warrant is a piece of paper issued to you by the MoD that can be exchanged at any train station for a train ticket at no cost to you. A rail warrant is shown below:

Issue and use of MOD rail warrants

- The National Rail helpline is available on 08457 484950 or www.nationalrail.co.uk.
- A rail warrant may be used to purchase travel on London Underground. It can form part of a National Rail network journey, such as a cross London transfer and where the departure/destination station is on the London Underground system, or where the journey is wholly on London Underground. This includes London Underground season tickets.
- The warrant is also used for sleeper reservations, and other authorized supplementary charges or services. Separate warrants may be required for each service.
- The background on the face of the warrant contains eraser sensitive UV inks. This cheque paper also contains a chain-link watermark. To verify hold to the light.
- Proof of Identity must be shown if requested by rail staff.
- Unused warrants or wholly, or partly, unused tickets must be returned to the MOD unit which issued the warrant.
- If found please return to: Service Manager, Warrants Service, PO Box 176, Stevenage, Herts, SG1 2YN.

When you arrive at the train station, you will hand in your rail warrant and they will give you back a train ticket at no extra charge like the one shown below:

PLUS BUS
